





FEATURED PORTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

KAIKOURA, NEW ZEALAND

Kaikoura draws visitors from all over the world for the prolific marine life in the surrounding waters. Whale (including sperm whales), dolphin and seal watching tours operate year-round.

PORT CHALMERS (DUNEDIN), NEW ZEALAND

Founded in 1848, Port Chalmers is the main port for the city of Dunedin. Today, numerous distinctive and historic buildings remain from the time of its predominantly Scottish settlers, preserving its architectural heritage.

TAURANGA (ROTORUA), NEW ZEALAND

Tauranga is the gateway to the Rotorua Thermal Area, a picturesque region of towering geysers, bubbling mud pots, steam vents and other volcanic phenomena.

MILFORD SOUND, NEW ZEALAND

New Zealand's most famous tourist destination, Milford Sound is a part of the Fiordland National Park and the Te Wahipounamu UNESCO World Heritage Site on the South Island.

MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA

Melbourne boomed in the Victorian gold rush, and by 1865 was the second largest city in the British Empire. Today, Melbourne is ranked as one of the world's most livable cities.

OBAN (HALFMOON BAY), NEW ZEALAND

Oban hangs beneath the South Island and is just about the last inhabited place before Antarctica. The island itself is only about four percent inhabited, and that is its attraction. It is an unspoiled piece of primeval New Zealand.

WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND

Wellington is nestled between a magnificent harbor and a natural amphitheatre of forest-clad hills. Its compact size, combined with cultural sophistication, makes it New Zealand's most inspiring urban destination.

PHILLIP ISLAND, VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA

The best of Australia all comes together across nature reserves with kangaroos, fur seals, occasional dolphins, orca and whales, and the sunset "penguin march" as the birds return to their beach nests

MATIATIA BAY, WAIHEKE ISLAND, NEW ZEALAND

Waiheke is an upscale island renowned for wineries, olive groves, art galleries, boutiques and restaurants. It is a favorite for laid-back walks and bike rides, bird watching, and even ziplining.

PICTON, NEW ZEALAND

Picton sits at the head of the Queen Charlotte Sound. It offers access to the Marlborough wine country, other spectacular sounds and outdoor activities such as kayaking, fishing and cycling.





EDEN, AUSTRALIA

This picturesque town near the border of New South Wales and Victoria was the site of a thriving shore-based whaling industry that depended on the cooperation of orcas, which herded baleen whales into Twofold Bay.

AKAROA (CHRISTCHURCH), NEW ZEALAND

Set on a beautiful, sheltered harbor and nestled in the heart of an ancient volcano, Akaroa is a popular resort village. This quaint seaside town has a distinct French flavor to it.

SLAWI BAY, KOMODO ISLAND, INDONESIA

Although known for the name it shares with its famed resident "dragons," Komodo is a rich island ecosystem that includes deer, wild pigs, birds, abundant tropical flora, and dolphins that frequent the bay's waters.

MORETON ISLAND, AUSTRALIA

Moreton is the third-largest sand island in the world. It is part of a sand barrier system and separates Moreton Bay from the Coral Sea about 27 miles north of Brisbane.

CAIRNS, AUSTRALIA

A sophisticated city flanked by forests and golden beaches, Cairns is the gateway to the Great Barrier Reef, Kuranda, and the Daintree Rain Forest, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.





ASIA

FEATURED PORTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

ISHINOMAKI, JAPAN

During samurai times, this port connected central and coastal Japan. Today, traces of that history can be seen in traditional inkstones and oyster cultivation, while modern manga art reflects more modern tastes.

TSURUGA, JAPAN

Mountainous landscapes and lush farmlands frame this quaint cultural region known for the crimson gates of the Takayama Inari shrine, folk songs, the Tachineputa museum and the Tsuruga Shamisen three-stringed lute.

SAKATA, JAPAN

For generations, Sakata has been a link between commerce and culture thanks to its historic blackroofed rice warehouses and gates, tiered Japanese gardens, art museums and a world-famous jellyfish aquarium.

HITACHINAKA, JAPAN

Long sandy beaches, ocean-front shrine gates, incredible seafood, and the bright seasonal colors of scarlet kochia bushes and pale pink yaezakura cherry blossoms make this Ibaraki coast destination truly unforgettable.

MIYAKOJIMA, JAPAN

Miyako Island, 300km south of Okinawa Island and famous for its beaches, is said to be Japan's most beautiful. Yonaha Maehama Beach is for swimmers, while Yoshino has great coral reefs and the white-sand Sunayama has dramatic rock formations.

KOBE, JAPAN

Kobe's ultra-modern Harborland, crowned by the Kobe Port Tower, offers a warm welcome. One of the first cities in Japan opened to trade, Kobe includes a venerable Chinatown and a section of 19th-century Western-style buildings in the Kitano neighborhood.

PETROPAVLOVSK (KAMCHATKA), RUSSIA

Dramatically sited on hills, the Kamchatka Peninsula on which Petropavlovsk sits is one of the most fascinating geographical features in the world. No roads lead to Kamchatka, a domain still largely given over to unbridled natural forces.

HO CHI MINH CITY, VIETNAM

Ho Chi Minh City covers an area of more than 800 square miles. Its land is overwhelmingly rural, dotted with villages and clusters of houses set amidst rice paddies.

MANILA, PHILIPPINES

The port of Manila is the largest and most important in the archipelago. The city of Manila proper, which boasts the densest population in the world, houses over 12 million people.

LAEM CHABANG (BANGKOK), THAILAND

Bangkok is a city of endless fascination. It is an exhilarating mix of chaos and refinement. There is a wealth of history and culture to be discovered here: palaces, temples, markets, and exquisite classical Thai dance performances.





HALONG BAY, VIETNAM

Scattered among picturesque karstic islands, communities of fishing families live on sampans, periodically going into towns such as Haiphong to sell their catch and buy supplies.

SIHANOUKVILLE, CAMBODIA

Sihanoukville, is located in southern Cambodia on the Gulf of Thailand, and is Cambodia's only international marine port. Its beaches are the most prominent natural feature of the city, spanning most of the surrounding coastline.

TIOMAN ISLAND, MALAYSIA

Made famous as a shooting site for the film South Pacific, this true-life location of Bali Hai offers diving, snorkeling, sunbathing on Paya Beach, surfing, hiking to Asah waterfall, and even golfing on this hidden-away paradise.

BAUBAU, INDONESIA

Tongkonan houses, ancient menhir "standing stones," and the classic lkat and other weavings of the Toraja peoples highlight this rich native culture. Don't miss seeing cave paintings at Leang Leang or snorkeling tropical reefs.

PUERTO PRINCESA, PHILIPPINES

Puerto Princesa occupies the mid-section of Palawan island in the southern Philippines. It is a center for eco-tourism in the archipelago, with notable coral reefs offshore including one, Tubbataha Reef, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

HUNDRED ISLANDS, PHILIPPINES

There are actually 124 islands in this Philippine National Park. Now covered with vegetation, they make a pleasing maze through which to thread in a small boat, either for snorkeling or to watch for some of the many forms of wildlife.

SHANGHAI, CHINA

"Paris of China" and "Pearl of the Orient," the vibrant city of Shanghai is a shining symbol of the economic emergence of the world's largest nation. A comfortable jumble of old and new, it is a city in seemingly unstoppable transition.

BUSAN (PUSAN), SOUTH KOREA

Busan is a mosaic of stunning beaches, international shopping, nightly light shows, and views from Busan Tower which thrill and excite, while the UN Memorial Cemetery and 40-Step sculptures honor the country's years at war.

KEELUNG (TAIPEI), TAIWAN

As a unique culture shaped by native Taiwanese, Spanish, Dutch, and even British influences, the architecture, museums, shrines, temples and markets, from Qingyu Hall to Lukang Old Street are varied and one-of-a-kind.

PHUKET, THAILAND

Blessed with stunning white-sand beaches, sapphire seas, exotic marine life and lushly forested hillsides, Phuket island is one of Southeast Asia's most popular destinations.







AQABA (PETRA), JORDAN


