

#### TRANSITING THE PANAMA CANAL

An unequaled feat of engineering, the 50-mile transit through the Panama Canal is an unforgettable voyage past beautiful bays, iconic bridges, tropical rainforests, and three impressive locks that raise and lower ships 85 vertical feet (26 meters) from one end to the other.

### MANTA (QUITO), ECUADOR


Manta's extensive port is a world center for tuna and other fishing, as well as banana agriculture, and its beaches attract surfers and windsurfers worldwide. From here, you can visit the national capital of Quito, a pleasant Spanish colonial UNESCO World Heritage Site located right on the Equator, scenically situated among Andean peaks at over 9,500 feet (2,896 meters).

#### EASTER ISLAND

Carved centuries ago in tribute to ancestors, the famed moai of this tiny island serve as monuments to the simple culture that dwells there still today. Volcanic hillsides, quaint farming villages, seaside shops and restaurants, and grassy, windswept shores reveal a surprisingly different side of the Pacific.



#### PAPEETE, TAHITI, FRENCH POLYNESIA

On the large island of Tahiti, Papeete blends romantic resorts and fine dining with vibrant markets and boutiques filled with exotic black pearls as well as native pareu wraps in floral prints and brilliant hues. Tour the lush countryside by open-air bus. Or, cross the narrow channel to Moorea which rises from the sea just like the fictional Bali Hai.

#### BORA-BORA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

Bora-Bora, has long been noted for its stunning beauty. A tiny island, less than 20 miles in circumference, Bora-Bora is dominated by the castle-like Mount Otemanu and Mount Pahia, two volcanic peaks with lush tropical slopes. A protective coral reef encloses Bora-Bora, and the lagoon is dotted with colorful motus, or islets. Perfect white-sand beaches give way to brilliant turquoise and sapphire-colored waters, and locals in the small village of Viatape sell colorful fabrics, sculptures carved from native wood and precious black pearls.

## RAROTONGA, COOK ISLANDS

This pristine, ocean outpost is a diverse land of emerald rain forests, a volcano, sugar-sand beaches, friendly culture, and crystal-clear lagoons. Trek through the colorful jungle on 4x4, sail the sparkling harbor, join in native song and dance, and experience the pure essence of the Pacific.

## TAVANIPUPU, SOLOMON ISLANDS

This 32-acre slice of paradise with warm, clear waters, lush coral reefs and soft sand beaches is located on the Marau Sound near Guadalcanal in the Solomon Islands. It is a privately owned resort, originally purchased in exchange for some ammunition by a party of Norwegian traders who operated a coconut plantation. Some of their gravestones are still to be found among the tall grasses.

#### CAIRNS, AUSTRALIA

A sophisticated city flanked by primeval forests and broad golden beaches, Cairns is the gateway to the natural splendors of the Great Barrier Reef, the Kuranda Scenic Railway, and the Daintree Rain Forest, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

#### PHILLIP ISLAND, AUSTRALIA

The best of Australia all comes together in a single compact destination. #### MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA

Eclectic and alive with color and music, Melbourne is Australia's unofficial capitol of culture. Colonial architecture and modern high-rises thrive side by side here alongside art galleries, museums, libraries, historic railways, stunning botanical gardens, vineyards, breathtaking beaches and unique native wildlife like koalas and penguins.


## PENNESHAW (KANGAROO ISLAND), AUSTRALIA

The lively township of Penneshaw has maritime ties dating back more than 200 years. Since then, the village-like atmosphere has grown beyond sailing and fishing and now includes a winery, ocean photo safaris, snorkeling, hiking and biking nature trails and sunbathing on uncrowded beaches.

Effortlessly laid-back and naturally gorgeous, this gem on the edge of the Indian Ocean is the perfect spot to snorkel in sparkling clear waters, sunbathe on uncrowded beaches and spot rare tropical birds in native palm forests.

## CASABLANCA, MOROCCO







#### TRANSITING THE PANAMA CANAL

In the pantheon of iconic travel experiences, a transit of the twisting waterways and mighty locks of the Panama Canal ranks near the top.

## FUERTE AMADOR (PANAMA CITY), PANAMA

Where the Panama Canal joins the Pacific sits the capital city of Fuerte Amador. More commonly known as Panama City, this overnight port offers insight into the Canal's history, the city's time as a Spanish fort and its present-day role as a major shipping destination and global center of research, business and entertainment.

#### MANTA (QUITO), ECUADOR

Manta is a commercial center for fish and fruit, particularly bananas and plantains. However its beaches, vibrant culture and quaint fishing villages have long attracted tourists. Shrimp, tuna and giant blue and striped marlin are abundant in the waters off its coastal plain.

## ISLAS GUAÑAPE, PERU


A cluster of four tiny islands off the coast of Peru are uninhabited by people, but are teeming with wildlife – particularly seabirds such as Humboldt penguins, blue-footed boobies, terns, and Southern sea lions who frequent these protected lands and waters.

## CALLAO (LIMA), PERU

Visit Lima, the "City of Kings" and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, prized for its grand palaces and churches, broad plazas, and unique style of art that blends classical forms with native traditions.

#### GENERAL SAN MARTIN (PISCO), PERU

Pisco dates from 1640, its Plaza de Armas is a Spanish colonial treasure. Another treasure are the Ballestas Islands, an offshore cluster of rocky outcroppings teeming with seabirds, penguins, sea lions, dolphins and other wildlife.

## ISLA PAN DE AZÚCAR, CHILE

"Sugar Loaf Island" is a nature sanctuary where breeding colonies of sea lions, sea otters, pelicans and other flora and fauna live peacefully among the rocky shores and arid climate influenced by the nearby Atacama Desert. Floating offshore, you'll be in a prime spot to see them all.

#### SAN ANTONIO (SANTIAGO), CHILE

This large, modern port serves Chile's capital, Santiago, a city with Spanish colonial charm and a vivacious spirit. Encircled by the Andes and the Coastal Range, Santiago is centered around the Plaza de Armas, with several of the city's landmarks: the 18th-century Metropolitan Cathedral the Palacio de la Real Audencia from 1808, the City Hall and the National Museum of History.

### PUERTO MONTT, CHILE

Captivating volcanic peaks, Chilean fjords, a vibrant fish market and harbor, and a bustling town-like atmosphere are all part of the colorful experience here. Explore white-water rafting, fly-fishing and hiking, or meander through craft stalls of handmade goods as you discover this multifaceted Pacific port.

#### THE SOUTH GEORGIA EXPERIENCE




## NEW ISLAND, FALKLAND ISLANDS

Wind-swept New Island, one of the world's most remote inhabited islands, lies on the western fringe of the Falklands Archipelago. 




